



HOW TO JOIN OUR MOVEMENT

The National Black Child Development Institute (NBCDI) is a membership-based organization with a National Village Network that serve local communities across the nation by carrying out our mission.

Joining NBCDI has never been easier! We have a new membership management platform called Glue Up, which has simplified the membership process. To help you become a member of NBCDI, whether at the national or local level, we have created a step-by-step guide. This guide includes screenshots that will assist you in navigating the registration process, regardless of whether you are a student, regular member, nonprofit, or corporate organization.

If there isn't a local village in your area, you can become a member of the national office. This membership gives you access to general information on all of our National Village Network, as well as information on national office events, publications, and resources. On the other hand, becoming a member of one of our

local Villages provides you with detailed and up-to-date information on community engagement opportunities, local resources, publications, and advocacy efforts. Additionally, you will have access to national office events, publications, and resources.

NBCDI MEMBERSHIP TYPES

There are four membership types:

- Student
- Regular Membership
- Nonprofit Member Organization
- Corporate Member Organization

Individuals or organizations can join NBCDI, either at the national level or through one of our 20+ villages across the country. The benefits of joining one of our villages include staying connected with the local community, attending local Village meetings and events, subscribing to newsletters, and volunteering. You can register directly with your local village's website or at **nbcdi.org**. If there isn't a local village in your geographic region, you can still become a member at the national level. The same membership types are available.



NBCDI MEMBERSHIP COSTS

Student Member: \$25

(must provide a copy of a student ID and/or current transcript)

Regular Member: \$40

Non Profit Member Organization: \$250

(includes 10 regular memberships for folks in your organization. You can register more than 10 at a rate of \$20 per additional member)

Corporate Member Organization: \$500

(includes 7 regular memberships for folks in your organization. You can register more than 7 regular members at a rate of \$70 per additional member)

NBCDI MEMBERSHIP APPROVALS

Student and Nonprofit Member Organization Memberships *require* individuals to upload and submit documentation to verify their student or nonprofit status in order to receive discounted membership rates. Once documentation is received, reviewed, and verified, individuals will receive an email requesting payment for their membership dues.





There are two ways for you to become a member:




- **Step 4:** This screen will indicate whether you've clicked to register as a student, regular, nonprofit, or corporate member.

Nonprofit Member Organization




Corporate Member Organization





Regular Member Screen










